He is a LEED Green Associate and Member of the Living Futures Institute, the organization that developed the ‘Living Building Challenge’. He works with clients and project teams to implement various high performance strategies that integrate project goals and team driven solutions. These solutions come from whole building design methodologies applied to site design, building orientation, building skin detailing, material selection, lighting and mechanical systems. His work includes a number of successful high performing projects including design of a net-zero energy (NZE) greenhouse and a LEED Platinum high school building.
